Aim

To assist managers in acquiring skills, to develop their staff members abilities and knowledge for recognising the signs and symptoms of abuse and neglect.

Objectives

- Explore the challenges and dilemmas around the threshold of significant harm.
- Recognise the importance of chronologies, analysis and decision making for individual children in cases of abuse.
- Reflect on intra-agency & inter-agency working together.
- Applying research to practice.
- Develop skills to remain child focused.
- Explore the meaning of particular events and situations for children.
- Consider the implications for managers and staff working with particular families.
